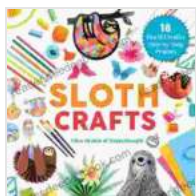

1. Felted Unicorn

Materials:

- White felt
- Multi-colored felt (for mane and tail)
- Pipe cleaner for the horn
- Embroidery thread
- Needle
- Scissors

Instructions:

1. Create the body by rolling up a piece of white felt and securing it with embroidery thread.
2. Cut out four legs from white felt and attach them to the body.
3. For the mane, cut strips of colored felt and glue them to the neck.

2. Paper Plate Shark



Materials:

- Paper plate
- Blue and white paint

- Googly eyes

- Cardboard
- Scissors

Instructions:

1. Paint the paper plate blue and let it dry.
2. Cut out a triangle from cardboard for the dorsal fin and glue it to the paper plate.
3. Cut out two smaller triangles from cardboard for the pectoral fins and glue them underneath the dorsal fin.
4. Glue on the googly eyes.
5. Cut out sharp teeth from white paper and glue them to the shark's mouth.

3. Origami Fox



Materials:

- Square piece of origami paper

Instructions:

1. Follow the classic origami fox folding instructions to create the basic shape.
2. Shape the ears by folding them down and then back up.
3. Create the snout by folding the front part of the head up.
4. Add the eyes and a tail by drawing them on.

4. Pom-Pom Owl



Materials:

- Yarn (in two colors for the body and wings)
- Cardboard or a pom-pom maker
- Scissors
- Googly eyes
- Felt scraps for the beak and feathers

Instructions:

1. Make two pom-poms using a pom-pom maker or by wrapping yarn around cardboard.
2. Attach the pom-poms together with yarn to form the body.
3. Cut out felt scraps for the wings and beak and glue them on.
4. Glue on the googly eyes.
5. Trim any excess yarn to shape the owl's feathers.

5. Clay Turtle



Materials:

- Polymer clay (brown, green, and yellow)
- Sculpting tools
- Toothpicks
- Googly eyes

Instructions:

1. Mix brown and green clay to create a speckled shell color.
2. Roll out the clay and cut out a disc for the shell.
3. Create the turtle's head and legs from brown clay.
4. Use sculpting tools to add texture to the shell and legs.
5. Attach the head and legs to the shell using toothpicks.
6. Glue on the googly eyes.

6. Perler Bead Dragon



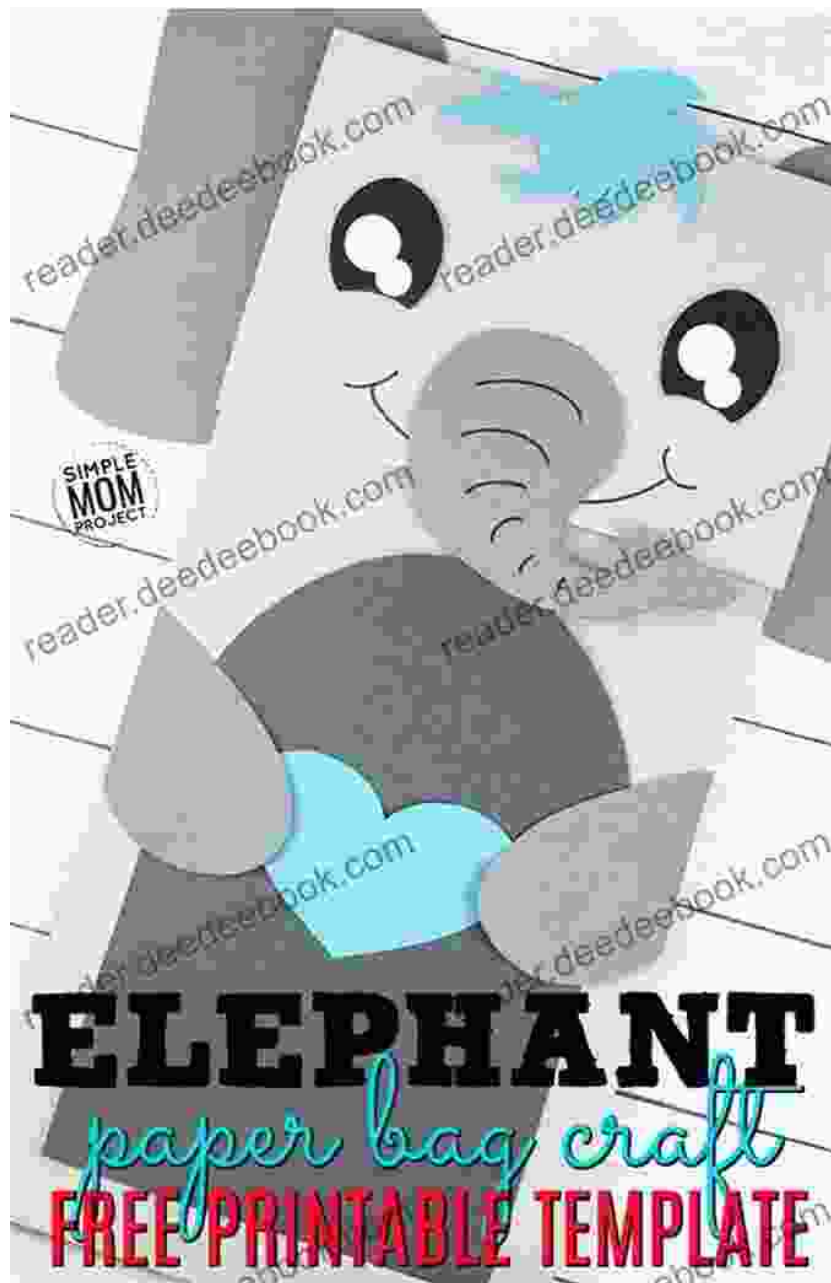
Materials:

- Perler beads in various colors
- Perler bead pegboard
- Ironing paper
- Iron

Instructions:

1. Design your dragon on the pegboard.
2. Cover the design with ironing paper.
3. Iron the beads until they melt and fuse together.
4. Let the creation cool completely.
5. Peel off the ironing paper and your dragon is complete.

7. Paper Bag Elephant



Materials:

- Brown paper bag
- Gray paint
- Paintbrush
- Black marker

- Scissors

Instructions:

1. Paint the bottom half of the paper bag gray and let it dry.
2. Fold down the top of the bag to create the elephant's head.
3. Cut out a trunk and ears from the remaining brown paper.
4. Glue the trunk and ears to the head.
5. Draw on the eyes and mouth with the black marker.

8. Cardboard Robot



Materials:

- Cardboard
- Scissors
- Glue or tape
- Markers or paint

- Straws (optional)

Instructions:

1. Cut out the different parts of the robot from cardboard (body, arms, legs, head).
2. Assemble the robot by gluing or taping the parts together.
3. Decorate the robot with markers or paint.
4. Insert straws into the arms and legs for added movement.

9. Sock Monkey



Materials:

- White socks (2 pairs)
- Brown yarn
- Buttons
- Needle and thread

- Stuffing (e.g., cotton balls, rice)

Instructions:

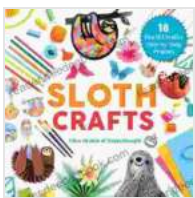
1. Turn one sock inside out and fill it with stuffing.
2. Wrap a piece of yarn around the sock's opening and pull to create the head.
3. Turn the second sock inside out and cut it in half for the arms and legs.
4. Sew the arms and legs to the body.
5. Create the tail by cutting a strip of fabric and sewing it to the back.
6. Sew buttons on for the eyes and mouth.

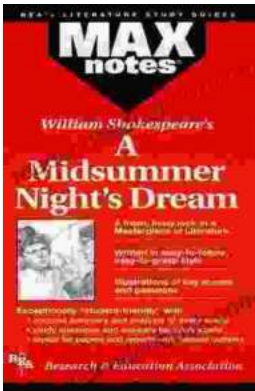
