- Fabric scraps in a variety of colors and patterns
- Backing fabric
- Batting

- Thread
- Needle
- Rotary cutter and mat (optional)
- Quilting ruler (optional)

Instructions

1.

Cut the fabric scraps. The first step is to cut your fabric scraps into strips. The strips should be 2 1/2 inches wide and the length will vary depending on the size of your quilt. For a quilt that is 50 inches by 60 inches, you will need to cut 160 strips.

2.

Sew the strips together. Once the strips are cut, you will need to sew them together to form logs. To do this, place two strips right sides together and sew them together along one long edge. Press the seam open. Repeat this process until you have 40 logs.

3.

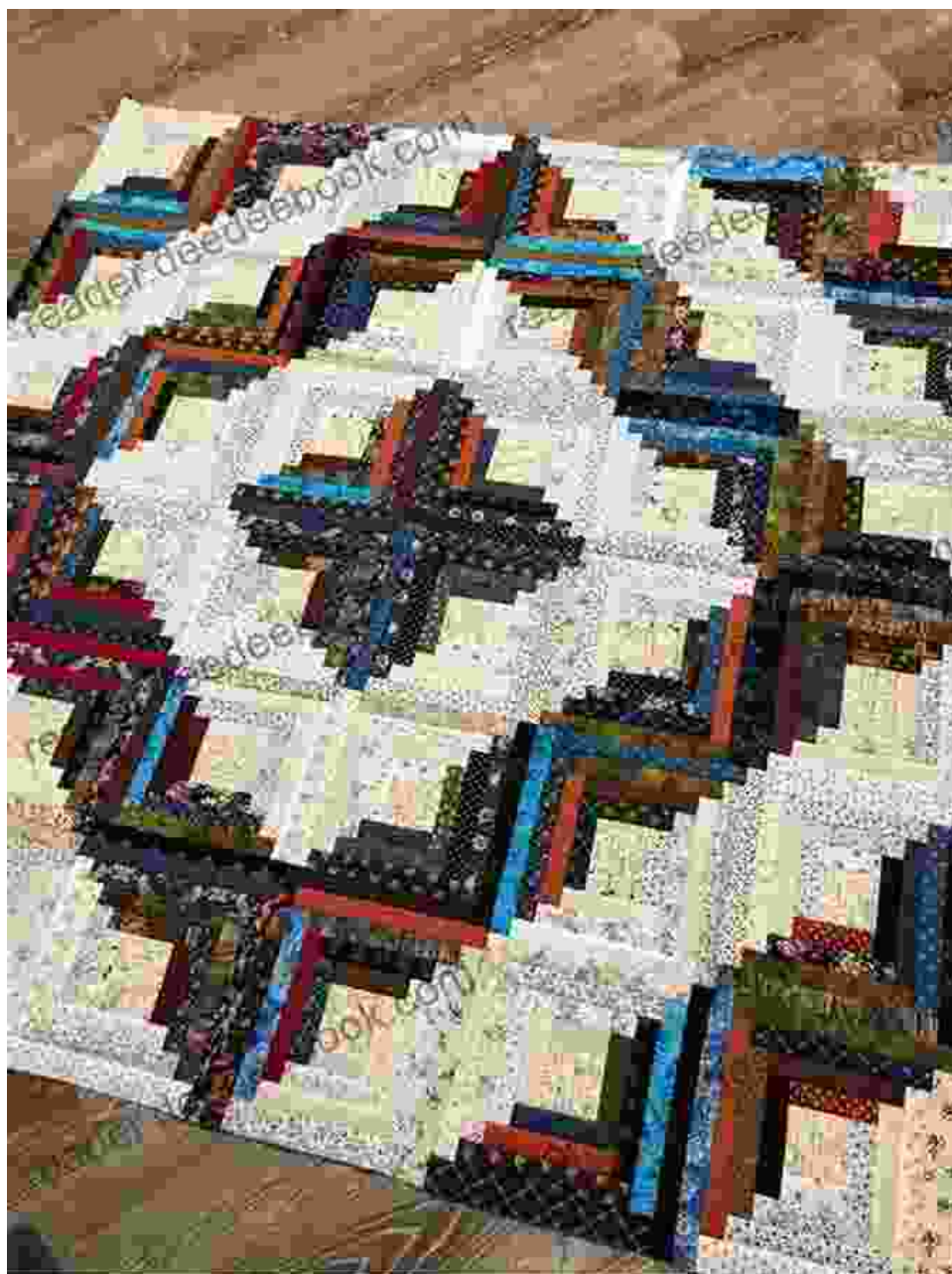

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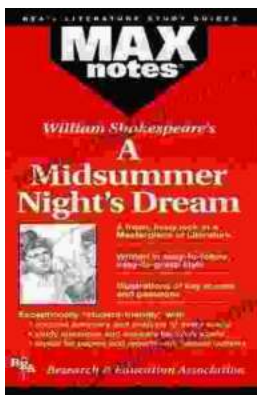
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
