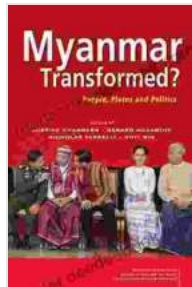


People, Places, and Politics: Myanmar Update Series

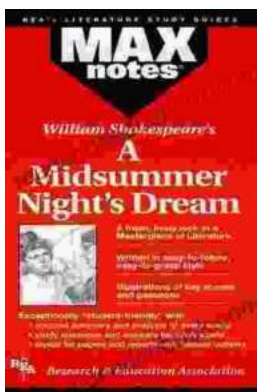
