7. Fasten off and weave in any loose ends.

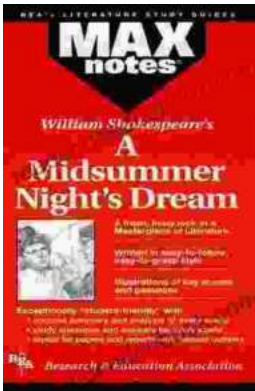
